


Installation & Operation Instructions Narrowstik





WARNING!

Do not install and/or operate this safety product unless you have read and understand the safety information contained in this manual.

- 1. Proper installation combined with operator training in the use, care, and maintenance of emergency warning devices are essential to ensure the safety of you and those you are trying to protect.
- 2. Exercise caution when working with live electrical connections.
- 3. This product must be properly grounded. Inadequate grounding and/or shorting of electrical connections can cause high current arcing, which can cause personal injury and/or severe vehicle damage, including fire.
- 4. Proper placement and installation are vital to the performance of this warning device. Install this product so that output performance of the system is maximized and the controls are placed within convenient reach of the operator so that s/he can operate the system without losing eye contact with the roadway.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the vehicle operator to ensure during use that all features of this product work correctly. In use, the vehicle operator should ensure the projection of the warning signal is not blocked by vehicle components (i.e., open trunks or compartment doors), people, vehicles, or other obstructions.
- 6. The use of this or any other warning device does not ensure all drivers can or will observe or react to a warning signal. Never take the right-of-way for granted. It is your responsibility to be sure you can proceed safely before entering an intersection, driving against traffic, responding at a high rate of speed, walking on or around traffic lanes.

Operating Environment:

Ambient Temperature: -10°C to 45°C

Relative Humidity: 10% to 85%, non-condensing

Mounting:

Mount the 37048AS LED light using the brackets supplied and user supplied mounting screws.

CAUTION: Check the chosen mounting location to ensure that the vehicle's structure and material is adequate to support the weight of your light. See #4 in Warning Box above.

Adjustment:

After the 37048AS light is securely installed, loosen the adjusting screws located on each end and tilt the light to the desired angle, then tighten the screws. Turn the LED light on and check the light from the front or rear of the vehicle through the window to ensure that it is at the most desirable angle, and that the light is not impeded by any obstacles and/or window tinting.

Operation:

ON/OFF FLASH SWITCH: The 3 states rocker switch used to control the LED flash brightness/ off states.

CENTER LEFT/ SWITCH: The rocker switch controls brightness from right to left. CENTER RIGHT/ SWITCH: The rocker switch controls LED function from left to right.

Note: Both CENTER switches in UP position puts unit in CENTER operation.

ON/OFF PATTERN SELECT MODES:


DN= Turn the 2 states switch to off/Turn the 3 states switch to DOWN mode.

UP= Turn the 2 states switch to on/Turn the 3 states switch to UP mode.

X= Turn the 3 states switch to MIDDLE position.

- The 3 states rocker switch in UP mode is in bright state/ in DN mode is dim state.
- Touching the yellow wire to the black wire (ground) will change the flash patterns.

Troubleshooting:

The 37048AS has been factory tested and approved. If the light fails to work, check the following:

- 1. Press the Function Switch (User Supplied) to be sure the "Off" pattern is not selected.
- 2. Remove the fuse from the vehicle fuse box and check to see if it has blown.
